From Dr. Jeffrey Young, Veterinary Surgeon

Dear Fellow Humanitarian,

Alex Pacheco has asked me to provide you with this information regarding what many consider to be the equivalent, to a **cure** for animal overpopulation.

This **cure** is based on finalizing the development of an edible sterilization *Dog Treat* (which will later be followed by an edible sterilization *Cat Treat*.)

This *Dog Treat* has a safe, sterilizing formula inside of it:
That will make a female dog reproductively sterile for life, without harm.
That will produce sterility in a female dog after eating just one Dog Treat.
That will in effect spay a female dog - without surgery.

As a veterinarian I have become deeply involved in this project and I am writing to everyone I can, because **this is a rare opportunity to end an unprecedented amount of animal suffering, in a essentially a single stroke.**

Because of this *Dog Treat*, we are on the verge of having the ability to *end* the cycle of suffering for the world's 600 million stray dogs, who reproduce uncontrolled, and who give birth every year to an estimated one billion stray pups.

In short, we are finalizing the *Dog Treat* that will allow society to humanely and quickly, end the overpopulation problem -- and we need your help. The primary obstacle slowing this down is the simple lack of funding . How much funding? *Nickels and dimes* compared to what is already being spent on dog and cat population control.

Literally over one billion dollars are spent on dog and cat population control in the United States alone - and over four million homeless dogs are still killed each year. This colossal amount of money is spent on animal control facilities and operations, humane society facilities and operations, spaying and neutering, trap and release programs, adoption programs, the list goes on and on -- and still the overpopulation problem continues, and the killing continues.

In sharp contrast, our *grassroots cost* to finalize the critical formula for world's first sterilization *Dog Treat* is projected to be between \$200,000 and \$400,000.

We will of course abide by all local, state and federal laws and regulations, and this dollar amount does not cover costs such as manufacturing or regulatory approval, which will vary country by country. *What this amount does cover, is the cost of the scientific breakthrough that can and will, change the world for suffering animals.*

This *Treat* will be an extremely valuable tool that will enable humane societies globally to *spay* millions upon millions of stray dogs - in a very short period of time, and without having to capture any of the strays and without having to perform surgery.

The end result: an unprecedented, humane "crashing" of the stray dog overpopulation. This will enable society to end the cycle of suffering - without euthanasia - and within **our** lifetime.

Again, we need your support. A donation of any amount will help, and just as importantly, please spread the word far and wide - please forward this letter to everyone you can.

Normally a pharmaceutical company would spend in excess of fifty million dollars developing and approving a *Dog Treat* like this - but in short, such companies are largely ignoring a treat such as this.

Therefore, it is up to each of us as humanitarians, to make this happen. At 600, we are using a grassroots approach and using creative strategies such as keeping the *Dog Treats* **non-profit**. In addition, the work is being performed outside the U.S. and the work is being performed by **non-profit scientists**.

The non-profit organization *600 Million Stray Dogs Need You* has been founded to succeed in this mission: To finance the creation of sterilization *Dog Treats*, and then use the treats to permanently end the dog overpopulation problem: Without handling the strays, without harming the strays, without surgery and without euthanasia. Furthermore: Within our life time.

We know this is a bold plan. An audacious plan. Some say it cannot be done - but we are confident it can be done.

Before I go any further, please allow me to introduce myself in brief. My name is Dr. Jeffrey Young and I am the Scientific Director for 600 Million Stray Dogs Need You -- and it is my honor to do so as a volunteer. I have also served as a veterinarian for over 20 years during which time I have trained over 300 veterinarians: in advanced spay neuter surgical sterilization techniques; I have established full-service animal hospitals in the United States, Europe and Mexico; I have served on the board of directors of numerous humane societies, and I am the founder of the non-profit Planned Pethood International, which is dedicated to humanely ending the overpopulation problem.

Back to current events: With adequate funding (described above) 600 Million Stray Dogs Need You is within 10 to 18 months away, from having the final formula for the world's first sterilization *Dog Treats* - and we need your help -- because we lack the funding to finish the *Dog Treats*. Currently, multiple doses are needed to produce sterilization, and we are now in the process of changing this, so that a **single** dose will produce sterilization.

We are non-profit and we must finance this ourselves. We receive no government grants and no support from any drug companies.

Instead we rely 100% on contributions from individual humanitarians such as yourself.

Why don't we go to the drug companies for the money? There are several reasons, beginning with this: If drug companies are given the chance, they will in all likelihood make the treats for-profit, and dramatically increase the price of the *Dog Treats*, making the *Treats* just as expensive as surgery. This has already happened with the dog sterilization injection, called Neutersol. (Neutersol is not a pill or a treat, and it must be injected into dogs.) Even though Neutersol has been approved by the FDA, it is peculiarly, not available in the U.S. -- and when it was available a few years ago, it was priced to cost just as much as a surgery.

Another reason: Over 30 years ago, a birth-control-dog-food was made by Carnation (the maker of *Mighty Dog* dog food). The New York Times reported on Carnation's public announcement that "within months" their birth-control-dog-food will be on store shelves all across America. To the best of our knowledge that was the last time anyone ever heard of Carnation's birth-control-dog-food. No one has ever been able to buy it. That was over 30 years ago.

These are just two reasons why we must keep some information confidential until the work is completed.

Until a non-profit patent application is filed, some of the ingredients are temporarily confidential and are disclosed on a need-to-know basis. At the same time, at this stage we can disclose that there are over 20 years of data on the ingredients, and that the formulas:

- Do not harm the animal.
- Do not harm or sterilize people.
- Do not transfer sterilization from one animal to another.
(Meaning: If a dog ate the treat and then an eagle ate the dog, the eagle would not be sterilized.)
- Do not have any known negative side effects when used as intended.
- Do not harm the environment.
- Do produce sterilization after multiple doses.

One primary reason the treats are safe, and do not have bad side effects when used as intended, is because these will only be eaten one time, or at most a few times, over the course of a lifetime.

This is very different from normal birth control pills. As you know, normal birth control pills are intended to be eaten every day, every week, every year, for years and years -- this adds up to thousands of doses being eaten over the course of a lifetime.

"How likely is it, that this will work?" The answer: Based on years of scientific data generated by numerous other scientists in more than one country, we have every reason and many reasons, to believe that this will work. In general terms, various species of animals (including dogs) have been given different versions of these formulas as far back as 5 years ago, and sterility has occurred without negative side effects.

"Why not make an injection formula?" To begin with, a single dose dog sterilization injection formula already exists, called Neutersol. Because it must be injected, it does not work when it is eaten. It is already approved by the FDA and is described as a "*99.6% effective, safe alternative to surgical castration*" for male dogs.

Unfortunately injections cannot end the cycle of suffering for stray dog populations because each dog must first be captured before they can be manually injected with Neutersol. Neutersol also requires two people to administer it, and other delivery methods such as dart guns and blow guns do not work with Neutersol because it must be injected directly into the testicles.

As you can see, edible *Dog Treats* are needed - because they can sterilize strays without having to capture or handle the animals. In short, injection formulas cannot solve the world's stray dog overpopulation problem, but edible formulas can, and as soon as we have the dog formula in hand, we will begin work on a formula for cats.

The reason we started with dogs is because the vast majority of data is on dogs -- meaning it should take less time to finalize a dog formula than a cat formula.

This project is being spearheaded by the internationally respected animal activist Alex Pacheco, who has been honored with many awards such as being voted into the U.S. Animal Rights Hall of Fame., as well as being voted *Crew Member of the Year* by The Sea Shepherd. (Most people know The Sea Shepherd because of Animal Planet's TV show called *Whale Wars*, which has been Animal Planet's # 1 rated show for almost five years.)

In the view of many including myself, Alex has the best track record of any individual, when it comes to leading and winning complex and difficult animal protection campaigns. In short, this project could not be in better hands.

Attached please see a brief biography of Alex, with a check list of just some of his landmark accomplishments for animals - such as closing down the first animal laboratory in the world because of cruelty to animals, then closing down the largest horse slaughtering company in the world, plus co-founding the largest animal rights organization in the world (PETA), plus co-founding the largest non-profit pet adoption service in the world, and more.


If you can do both, please do both.

Attached: One page biography of Alex Pacheco

Alex Pacheco

2009-Present: Founder of 600 Million Stray Dogs Need You, dedicated to ending animal overpopulation using sterility pills which can replace surgery and euthanasia, as methods of population control.

2000-2005: Co-Founder of the world's largest non-profit animal adoption website, Adopt-A-Pet.com which now has over 100,000 homeless animals and over 1,000 humane societies participating.

1985-1995: Vice President for 10 years of the non-profit New England Anti-Vivisection Society, an animal protection lobbying related organization with working assets of eight million dollars.

1980-2000: Four years after graduating from high school, he co-founded the world's largest and leading animal rights organization, PETA. He served as Chairman for 20 years before leaving in 2000, during which time the organization was described by the New York Times as the animal movement's "mover and shaker". As Chairman he was in charge of PETA's investigators, lobbyists, lawyers and fundraising staff. PETA currently generates \$35 million in annual revenue with two million members.

He served as PETA's lead undercover investigator and legal tactician, successfully defeating and out maneuvering a long list of adversarial Cabinet level federal agencies, such as the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, the U.S. Department of Defense, the USDA, the NIH, NASA and numerous others; including winning many landmark cases against many of the nation's largest corporations such as General Motors and Exxon. His precedent setting work includes the first police raid of an animal research facility; the first confiscation of animals from a biomedical laboratory, the first arrest, prosecution and criminal conviction of a biomedical scientist on charges of cruelty; the first, second and third terminations of federal research grants due to cruelty; the first closing of a U.S. Pentagon animal laboratory, the closing of the world's largest horse slaughtering company, and more.

Additional successful campaigns include forcing dozens of major corporations such as General Motors (at the time the world's largest corporation), Texaco, Exxon, Mobil Oil, L'Oreal, Avon, Revlon, Amway, Benetton and others, to end various inhumane practices.

Pacheco planned and executed landmark undercover investigative work inside a federally funded research facility, producing a civil and criminal case cited by film director Oliver Stone and others, as *the* case that launched the U.S. animal rights movement: *The Silver Spring Monkeys*. Spanning 15 years, the cases were heard before the U.S. Supreme Court twice, involved hundreds of Members of Congress, over 55 U.S. Senators, and led to hearings and passage of federal animal protection legislation.

Pacheco was the undercover investigator and directed the lobbying and litigation throughout the 15 year international campaign, leading to a Harvard University study on how to defeat the animal protection movement, commissioned by the American Medical Association, which described Pacheco as a "folk hero".

Pacheco started PETA with no funding, no college degree, no staff and no experience; he played a key role in building the organization from scratch to the point where anyone can mail an envelope from anywhere in the U.S., with nothing more on the envelope than "PETA" written on it, and the letter will still be delivered.

He was awarded the Crew Member of the Year Award by the Sea Shepherd Conservations Society (aka Animal Planets TV series Whale Wars); was voted into the U.S. Animal Rights Hall of Fame; was awarded The Peace Abbey Courage of Conscience Award; for one year lived with seven Brothers and three Priests while studying to become a Catholic Priest in the Scholastic Program for Ecclesiastical Students at Ohio State University; etc.

Deans List: Ohio University 1976-77, Ohio State University 1977-78, George Washington University, 1979-1980; left George Washington University to co-found PETA instead of graduating.
